Please consider the following before attending school/work.	
Temperature:	(must be less than 100.0 degrees)
Is the student/are you experi	encing any of the following symptoms?

Has the student/or you been told to quarantine or meet requirements for quarantine?

• Non-vaccinated and within 6 ft for a cumulative total of 15 minutes or more outside of classroom setting or a household contact to a person who is COVID-19 positive

Has the student/or you recently been tested for COVID-19 due to symptoms and waiting for results?

Stay home and contact the school nurse if you or the student:

- Have one or more symptoms in Group A OR
- Have two or more symptoms in Group B **OR**
- Are taking medications to reduce fever such as Ibuprofen (i.e., Advil, Motrin) or Acetaminophen (Tylenol)
- Answers **yes** to the above questions

The length of time that students/staff need to stay home will depend on public health guidelines at that time.

Testing is recommended for the student/staff members with symptoms as above:

- If improved symptoms and PCR/NAAT (not rapid antigen) test result is negative OR doctor's note with an alternative confirmed diagnosis, return to school after 24 hours with no fever (off fever-reducing medications).
- If symptoms persist, and PCR/NAAT (not rapid antigen) test result is negative **retesting and alternative diagnosis is recommended after 72 hours**, return to school after 24 hours with no fever (off fever-reducing medications).
- If test result (antigen "rapid" or PCR/NAAT) is positive or individual is unable/refuses to get tested, may return to school after:
 - 24 hours with no fever (off fever-reducing medications) and improvement in symptoms and
 - o after a full 10 days since symptoms first appeared

If you would experience any of the following symptoms, it is a **TRUE EMERGENCY**!

Call 9-1-1 IMMEDIATELY!

These include:

- Trouble Breathing
- Persistent pain or pressure in the chest
- New confusion or inability to arouse/awaken
- Bluish lips/face/fingers

***Please notify your child's School Nurse if your child is being tested for COVID-19, has tested positive for COVID-19, or is being quarantined at home at the request of the PA DOH. You may be required to bring a note from your healthcare provider or the Public Health Department before returning to school.
